Dear families:

After a fantastic spring with UNICEF Kid Power, we have some exciting news! **On Wednesday, June 8, the UNICEF Kid Power Band your child is using will switch to the UNICEF Kid Power family experience until March 1, 2017.**

This means that every step your child takes throughout summer and next school year will continue to make a difference in the fight against global malnutrition!

Here's how it will work:

- **Step 1:** Download the UNICEF Kid Power App on select* smartphone or tablet devices.
- **Step 2:** Once the app is installed, create an account and follow instructions to link your child's Kid Power Band. (Note: adults do not need a Kid Power Band to create Family Accounts.)

- **Step 3:** Start your mission and sync!

The Global Kid Power Mission with Alex Morgan and the *Star Wars: Force for Change* mission are **free of charge** for your child to use. We recommend your child go on the Global Mission with Alex Morgan first. Sync the Kid Power Band to the app to begin the mission!

- **Step 4:** Keep the Kid Power Band charged! Why?
 - You child can continue to **get active and saves lives** with the UNICEF Kid Power Band until March 1, 2017.
 - There may be more free missions released in the future. In addition to the free missions, additional missions can be purchased from the App Store or on Google Play for \$3.99 each. (Why are there paid missions? The purchase price helps pay for therapeutic food packets to be

unlocked at a faster rate: one therapeutic food packet is unlocked for every 10 Kid Power Points during a mission, instead of 25 Kid Power Points when not on a mission.)
